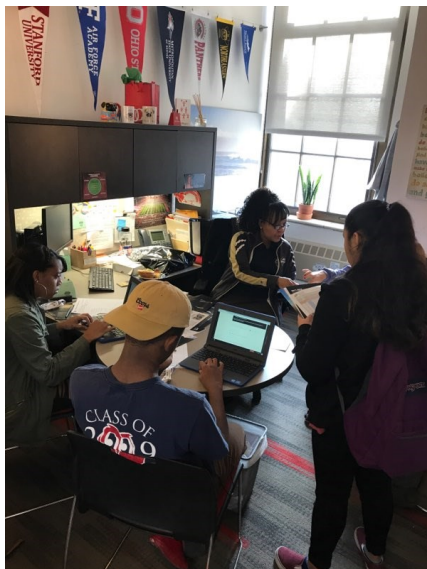
Calling all Juniors!
