 - User name is student id #; Password is 6-digit birthdate

 - All – MY ICAP Survey
 - All - 4 year course planner
 - 9th and 10th grade – strength and career inventories
 - 11th – resume and junior personal statement
 - 12th – college process and financial aid information
 - College search process and scholarship search
