The AP Scholarship was established in 2013 through grant funding to meet the financial needs of students who could not afford the AP test fee. This AP Scholarship will reduce the AP Test Fee \$94. (Student pays \$20 if awarded for <u>one</u> test) Applications will be reviewed by a panel composed of Administrators, Counselors, and Student services staff.

This scholarship may only be awarded to <u>ONE (1)</u> AP course.

Deadline for this application is Wednesday, March 21, 2018 by 3pm. <u>Applications must be</u> <u>submitted to DeAnna Carri, East High School Treasurer.</u> (Located next to the East Spirit Store-2nd Floor) Notifications about AP Scholarship awards will be sent to applicants via email by **Tuesday, April 10, 2018**.

** Please do not complete the AP Scholarship application if you are eligible for Free & Reduced lunch. Students who are eligible for Free & Reduced lunch must fill out FRL Waiver form by March 21, 2018 to have reduced AP Test fee.(Students pay \$16 per test) Forms are available through DeAnna Carri, East High School Treasurer. **
