

## AP World History Summer Assignment 2019-2020 Details

When you log in to **Persuall.com** with the code **ANDERSON-KRFGY**, you will automatically be assigned a group of 4 students. You will be anonymous to each other, but not to the instructors. All work must be in your own words and not copied from any other source or your peers.

You will be reading 2 chapters from *A History of the World in 6 Glasses* (Chapter 3: The Delight of Wine and Chapter 4: The Imperial Vine.)

To annotate the chapters, select "A" at the top of the page to "Annotate Text" and select "New." Highlight a portion and then type in a unique comment or question. You will be able to view your group's annotations.

You will be engaging in an online discussion with your peers. Below are the bare requirements of the assignment. You may need to log in multiple times to view other's comments and questions. You can begin with your own definitions and questions.

### Each Student is Responsible for:

1. Defining 2 terms they do not know in the reading. Do not duplicate terms.
2. Making 2 thoughtful personal connections or comments.
3. Posing at least 2 open-ended discussion questions.
4. Responding to 2 other questions posed by peers. Please write in complete sentences.

### Possible Sentence Stems for Posing Questions:

- What social, political, and technological ideas affected the knowledge about...?
- What are the reasons, motivations, or events that underlie...?
- What additional information is necessary for us to be able to make a conclusion regarding...?
- What patterns do you find in...?
- What elements, events, or ideas are repeated in...?
- How might \_\_\_\_\_ change over time?
- How is \_\_\_\_\_ related to \_\_\_\_\_ during \_\_\_\_\_(a particular time period)?
- What specialized language is needed to define/describe \_\_\_\_\_ (an event/situation)?

- What different/conflicting opinions have been expressed about \_\_\_\_\_?
- What general statement summarizes \_\_\_\_\_?

- What are the characteristics/attributes of \_\_\_\_\_?
- What distinguishes \_\_\_\_\_ from \_\_\_\_\_?
- How is \_\_\_\_\_ related to similar ideas in science, social studies, math, and language arts?
