News from the Nursing Office

Currently, the Colorado pediatric hospitalization rate associated with Respiratory Syncytial Virus (RSV) far exceeds influenza and COVID-19 hospitalizations though influenza and COVID-19 levels are increasing as well.

DPS will be adopting some extra measures suggested by the Colorado Department of Health

and Environment,

- It is recommended that any student with a positive RSV symptoms remain home for 72 hours from the initial onset of their symptoms. Symptoms: https://www.cdc.gov/rsv/about/symptoms.html
- 2. Strongly encourage your children to mask at school, even if experiencing even mild respiratory symptoms.
- 3. We will continue to use the **How Sick is Too Sick Spanish**, encourage regular hand washing, sneeze/cough etiquette and increase our frequency of cleaning and disinfecting of high touch surfaces.
- CDC encourages annual flu vaccination as well as all recommended doses of COVID-19 vaccines. It is safe to get the vaccines together. There is currently no vaccine for RSV.

The RTD mobile app is now live!

Students who are eligible for DPS RTD tickets can now download the mobile ticketing app. Follow the instructions in **this flier** to get your monthly pass through the app now.

Eligibility Information: A student who resides more than 2.5 miles from his/her neighborhood high school and attends this school, or a student who attends a high school magnet program and resides more than 2.5 miles from the location of the magnet program, is eligible for the DPS-RTD pass.

Students who attend a school other than their neighborhood school through the SchoolChoice process are not eligible for the DPS RTD student pass.
