Fall Testing Update

East High School will administer the PSAT/NMSQT to all 10th and 11th grade students on October 12th and the PSAT8/9 to all 9th grade students on October 13th. By taking these exams, students will gain information regarding their readiness for college, have access to scholarships, and practice for the SAT. As a practice test, the fall administration will allow for plenty of time for intervention when a student is identified as

needing extra support leading up to other standardized tests and ultimately college or careers. These are the only dates that fall testing will be offered. If you have any questions reach out to our Site Assessment Leader Jessica Perkins Jperkin@dpsk12.net

Students will be assigned to test rooms based on their grade level in Infinite Campus and will receive an email about their room assignments the week before testing.

Wednesday Oct 12

- All 10th and 11th grade students will take PSAT/NMSQT.
- Students should plan to arrive at 8:00 am.
- Testing will end around 12:00 pm. End times may vary by testing room.
- There will be no school for 9th and 12th grade students.

Thursday Oct 13

- All 9th grade students will take PSAT8/9.
- Students should plan to arrive at 8:00 am.
- Testing will end around 11:10 am. End times may vary by testing room.
- There will be no school for 10th, 11th, and 12th grade students.

East Equitable Grading Practices Feedback

East has adopted 3 equitable grading strategies this year so that student grades will be more accurate, bias resistant, and motivational. Our goal is to ensure student grades communicate student learning and progress. Advisement at Home

This week in advisement, students watched the district's lock down video and had a brief discussion as to why we practice emergency procedures. Students then learned how to check grades and received grade level announcements.

Continuing the conversation at home:

-Ask your child how they felt watching the lockdown video and see if they have questions or concerns. How can you help your child prepare for these practice procedures.

-Ask your child if they know how to check their grades, have them show you.

-Have one more conversation about homecoming and planning for a fun and safe experience.

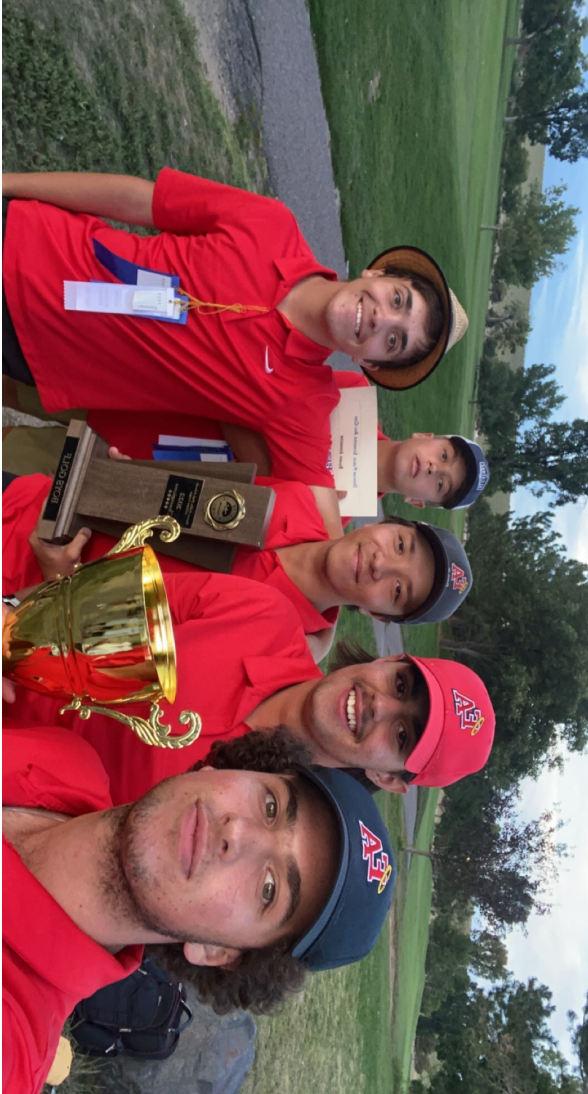
