

Guide to Health Visits

School Nurse: Room 130 at the front of the school

- Can provide you a space to rest if you are not feeling well - **for a reasonable time limit.**
- **Cannot** let you lay down for the entire school day
- Cannot give you a pass for no reason
- Can provide you with health advice
- Can provide you with condoms
- **Cannot** give you a COVID/flu/strep test
- Can complete basic vision and hearing screens
- **Cannot** prescribe you medications
- Can only give medications that have been ordered by a doctor and brought to school by your parent/guardian and stored in the Nurse Office.
- **Cannot** give any medications that weren't prescribed by a doctor
- Can store your emergency medications such as inhalers, EpiPens, and seizure medications
- Can provide feminine hygiene products
- Can provide snacks/water
- Can connect you with resources for food/clothing/housing/transportation

Denver Health Clinic: Room 139/140 behind the auditorium

- Can only see you with an appointment(same day appointments usually available).
- No parental consent needed for **Confidential Visits.**
- Parental consent needed for regular medical visits.
- Can provide physical exams.
- Can care for chronic conditions such as asthma.
- Can care for acute injury and illness.
- Can provide immunizations
- Can provide testing such as Covid/Flu/strep test.
- Can prescribe medications.
- Can provide confidential visits, prescribe birth control and confidential testing.
- Can connect you with mental health resources.
- Can connect you with dental services.
